

# 2<sup>nd</sup> International CILS4EU User Conference

## January 24-25, 2018



### CALL FOR PAPERS

The Children of Immigrants Longitudinal Survey in Four European Countries (CILS4EU) provides a unique data source to study integration processes among immigrant adolescents in England, Germany, the Netherlands and Sweden. Given the survey's broad scope, CILS4EU-data comprise a wide array of information on different aspects of the cognitive-cultural (e.g., language skills and usage), structural (e.g., educational and occupational success), social (e.g., friendship formation or partner choices) and emotional-cultural dimension of integration (e.g., religion or identity). In addition to data from the three international waves, which were made available to the scientific community at the GESIS Data Archive for the Social Sciences, follow-up waves were collected in the various countries. With the CILS4EU data becoming more and more popular, we want to offer users the opportunity to present their current research based on CILS4EU-data (completed or ongoing), to share their experiences, and to get into contact with the international CILS4EU-team. Potential contributions are not restricted to integration-related work. We welcome any contribution that makes use of the CILS4EU data, be it on any substantive topic or with a methodological focus.
