

Youth in Europe Study

A survey of 16-17 year olds in England, Germany, Sweden and the Netherlands

Key

This document shows the question wording for the web and telephone (CATI) questionnaires.

- The question name used in the programme for questions is written in the box under the question number
- In single questions, the name will appear in the black box
- In questions that are split (e.g. Q5) the name will appear in the box next to the answer option
- Interviewer instructions are written in upper case. Where the interviewer instruction is 'READ OUT', the interviewer will read all the answer options to the respondent in full.
- The telephone (CATI) version of the question has only been entered where it differs from the web version and is prefixed with 'CATI:'
- The name of each block is in the grey box at the top of each block in square brackets []

*For example, in the question below the question name is **DOB**.*

If a young person answers this question in the web survey they will be asked 'When were you born?'.

If a young person is taking part by telephone the interviewer will say "Can I just check, what is your date of birth?" and the interviewer will enter the response in the DDMMYYYY format.
